

Procon Points Policy

Procon utilizes a policy whereby points are allocated to members based on their degree of club participation. Points are earned through club involvement and used towards attaining discounts on team clothing and qualifying for hotel reimbursement and product deals. The reward and point allocation structure are described below. For points that you the member a responsible for reporting, there is a 30 day cut-off. If you report the points after 30 days you will not receive them. An example of this is races.

- Tier 1 – 60 points, 2 volunteer days , 7 meetings, and 20 races– 50% off of the next year’s initial clothing order, qualify for the next year’s per diem(if available), race reimbursement, additional discount on team deals
- Tier 2 – 35 points, 2 volunteer days, 5 meetings – 50% off of the next year’s initial clothing order, qualify for the next year’s per diem(if available)
- Tier 3 – 20 points, 2 volunteer days, 3 meetings – 25% off of the next year’s initial clothing order
