



Usery Pass RR 2006

New course for 2006

One more leg-burning climb this year!

2006 will see the riders heading up the climbs of Usery Pass, Saguaro, and Kong

Road Race February 5th

RR Location: Usery Pass, Mesa AZ. Parking, registration and warm-up at Salt River Recreation Area at the base of Usery Pass (see map below).

REGISTRATION: There will be no mail in registration. Registration will be only on [active.com](http://www.active.com) only. Day of race registration will be available. **Registration closes promptly at 7:15am.** The cost is \$20 for everyone but juniors, they race free. There is a \$5 late fee and a \$5 unattached fee. Field limit for the senior men 5 is 50. If need be there will be a second category 5 men race that will start last. All riders must have a valid USCF license. One day or annual licenses may be purchased at the race. Entry fee includes insurance for all riders. USCF rules will apply.

All riders must sign standard USCF release form at race. Register at [Active.com](http://www.active.com).

Directions from Phoenix / Flagstaff: I-17 to Rte 101 to Shea Blvd to Rte 87 north. Turn right onto Saguaro lake turnoff. Continue till you come to Usery Pass Rd.

Directions from Tucson: I-10 north to Highway 60 East. Turn North onto Loop 101 and then East onto Loop 202. Exit Power and go left. Follow this until you reach the Usery Pass Rd.

INFO: Race route starts at the Recreation Area and then goes WEST up Kong and return, then up Usery and return, then out Saguaro and return, then back to Kong. Finish will be uphill on Usery. The feed zone is located on the top of the climb to the Saguaro Lake turnoff. More details available at registration. All roads will be open to traffic. Yellow line rule STRICTLY enforced. Wheel support by follow vehicles - wheels in wheels out until you are told otherwise.
